– Since 1979, I have contributed to the major assyriological project *Archives Royales de Mari* (ARM), under the direction of Jean-Marie Durand since 1982, funded by the French CNRS; I have been acting as co-director since 2009. The traditional French research organization did not operate with a system of grants, but with fixed positions and regular funding through the UMR (*Unités mixtes de recherche*) of the CNRS. The ARM is a program of UMR 7192, of which I have been co-director for 8 years (2011-18).

– I also contributed to other programs within the UMR 7192, i.a. to the ANR/DFG programs HIGOMES and TEXTELSEM on the historical geography of Upper Mesopotamia (dir. N. Ziegler and E. Cancik-Kirschbaum).
